VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

AREAS TO VOLUNTEER:

Peer Advocate -

Opportunity to meet one on one with clients, while working on lessons provided through our Earn While You Learn Program.

Women & men are welcome, speaking Spanish is a helpful bonus.

Level 1 Advocate Training is required. Time commitment varies and is flexible.



Pregnancy Option Educator -

Opportunity to meet with women facing an unplanned pregnancy. Meeting one on one with client, sharing truthful information about pregnancy options: Parenting, Adoption & Abortion. (FRCZ does NOT perform or refer for abortion)

Level 2 Advocate Training is required. Time commitment varies and is flexible.

Sonographer -

Opportunity to meet with women facing an unplanned pregnancy. Sharing the view of life in the womb; verifying the presence of life and an intrauterine pregnancy.

Volunteers are required to be a licensed RN and complete Sonographer certification. Time commitment varies and is flexible.

Bible Study Facilitator -

Opportunity to meet with women (or men with men) that have experienced an abortion or past sexual trauma. Meeting her right where she is at and leading her through the redeeming forgiveness that can only come through our loving God.

Training is required – all facilitators must go through the study prior to facilitating.

Sexual Risk Avoidance Facilitator -

Opportunity to meet with youth, sharing information about having "No Regrets" when it comes to sexual purity. (New Program)

Training is required.



Boutique Worker -

Sorting donations, preparing boutique for clients. Numerous opportunities available. All are welcome.
