Thank you for your willingness to serve as the Walk for Life 2026-point person at your church or group. Having one person to help oversee communication and encouragement makes a tremendous difference in participation. This is not a big job, but it truly makes a big impact!

**The Walk for Life is an opportunity to bring awareness to the Sanctity of Human Life while also raising vital financial support for the ministry of Family Resource Center.**

Below are a few simple suggestions to help you promote the Walk for Life:

**Familiarize yourself with the details**

- Review the online platform and sponsor sheet so you can answer questions.
- The Walk is approximately 2 miles. Children and strollers are welcome.
- The Walk will meet at a **new location this year: Shiloh Park, Kiwanis Shelter.**

**Important details to share**

- Raise **\$75 in donations** and receive a **FREE Walk for Life t-shirt.**
- **Long-sleeve shirts are available with a prepaid order.**
- **Early Registration** will be held at the Family Resource Center, May 11–14 (Monday–Thursday) from 10am–4pm. Walkers can pick up their t-shirts at that time.

**Ways to encourage participation**

- Ask your Pastor/Leader to share about the Walk from the platform.
- Request a bulletin announcement at least four weeks prior or ask to say a few words during announcements.
- Plan to walk yourself on **May 16 at Shiloh Park** and invite others to join you. (Remember—\$75 earns a t-shirt!)
- Encourage youth groups, small groups, and ministry groups to form teams and even have friendly competition to see who can raise the most support or bring the most walkers.
- Consider setting an all-church/group goal, such as a fundraising amount or number of walkers.
- Encourage those unable to walk to sponsor someone who is.
- Reach out to FRC for a yard sign to advertise event.
